






#### **Democratic Participation or Participatory Democracy**





#### Summary

- relatively small sample (1243 feedbacks) but some large network-level responses
- 56% confirmed relevance of Erasmus+ objectives
- 75% felt that engagement of person with fewer opportunities was effective;
- >70% confirmed continuing value of educational mobility and need to retain;
- 73% confirmed continuing value of cooperation partnerships and need to retain.
- ... but is this just self-propagation or self-importance... probably not!
